Unauthorised Absence Requests

I have noticed over the last term there has been an increase in Absence Requests. I would like to remind parents that full and regular attendance at school is crucial for future life chances. It establishes a positive work ethic early in life. It is therefore important to ensure that children achieve maximum possible attendance and that any problems that prevent full attendance are communicated to the school. The Education (Pupil Registration)(England)(Amendment) Regulations 2013, which became law on 1st September 2013 state that Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. According to our Attendance Policy, section 8 states:

- Parents must call each day of their child's absence stating symptoms and likely date of return - "unwell" is not enough.
- If attendance continually remains under 95% the child will be monitored and medical evidence, if appropriate, may be required.
- Failure to comply with expectations set by EWO may result in further action (Court Prosecution)

If you take your child out of school without the approval of the school, you will be liable to receive a Penalty Notice from Surrey County Council for failing to ensure your child's regular school attendance. Each parent will be liable to receive a Penalty Notice for each child (5 years of age and over) who is absent. The Penalty Notice is for £60 (per parent/per child) if paid within 21 days and £120 per parent if paid after 21 days, but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice will result in you being served with a summons to appear at the Magistrates Court.

As a school we have put in place ways to praise good attendance and celebrate this in the parent community. I appreciate your support in this matter.
